8. Travel Reminder

If your child has been ill or has a fever (100.4 degrees +) within the past 24 hours they must stay at home. If you believe your student could have been within 6' for 10-15 minutes with someone who is COVID positive, they must quarantine for 14-days. This is critical to our continued safety. First, I need to share some important news. We are <u>temporarily</u> moving to **ONLINE WORSHIP ONLY**, **effective immediately**, through 2020. This is in response to the appeal from the Cuyahoga County Board of Health for all organizations to help stem the rise of COVID-19 infections. Out of an abundance of care and concern for our church family, the leadership team feels we need to take this necessary precaution. We will continue to monitor the situation, and after Christmas, will do a re-evaluation based on the information we have at that time.

Traditional worship will be livestreamed at 8:30 AM; contemporary worship at 10:00 AM. Both will be recorded and available for later viewing. We sincerely appreciate your understanding and patience as we navigate this ever-changing situation.
