Greetings from the Florida Keys! Karla and I are incredibly thankful for this time of rest and relaxation. I look forward to seeing you again soon.

After thoughtful prayer and discussion, we are <u>temporarily suspending</u> the 8:30 am service, <u>effective February 13</u>. We will continue to monitor the situation and hope to resume the 8:30 service by Holy Week. Thank you for your understanding.

This month we are spotlighting the Domincan Republic mission trip. A team of 18 people (men, women, and teens) will leave for the DR on a 9-day mission trip, February 25 – March 5. This is the 15<sup>th</sup> year a team will travel to Los Alcarrizos, a community northwest of the capital city of Santo Domingo. Team members will continue construction work on a First-Attention Medical Center in the community of Villa Altagracia, offer Vacation Bible School to school children, and host a Dominican women's Bible study. The team hopes to raise \$35,000 to build the medical center foundation, as well as bring material goods to support the school and community. Donation lists are located outside of each worship space. How can you bless the DR mission trip?
