Dear Royal Redeemer Family:

I have some important announcements to share...there are some big changes underway!

As of March 1, Pastor Mark Rein is a full-time Assistant Pastor at Royal Redeemer! We are incredibly blessed to have him available to assist in all areas of ministry. Some of his responsibilities will include providing support for our care ministries and mission opportunities, hospital visits, adult Bible studies, teaching religion and leading RRLS chapel as needed. Please join me in praying for Pastor Rein as he begins this full-time pastoral position. Congratulations!

Next, we are very excited to share that we will be launching a two-phase "refresh/renovation" project! Design plans are underway to make some much-needed aesthetic improvements to the Sanctuary and portions of our HVAC system in the Narthex (which lacks AC in the summer) and the offices throughout the west wing of the church. The project scope includes new pews, removal of wood planks along the walls, new carpet, replacing dated finishes, new LED screens, and light, sound & visual technology upgrades.

I'm sure you have lots of questions, and we'll do our best to provide information and updates along the way. For the time being, a Q&A sheet is available outside of each worship space.
