Scholarships will be prioritized for students of low-income households.

SGOs (Scholarship Granting Organizations) are NEW: they were recently brought into existence in last year's Ohio legislative session.

You, the taxpayer and donor, can select the participating school(s) to which you'd like your donation directed.

The LGSOO is a recognized charitable organization under Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code.

Starting January 17: Open registration for all new families in our community

REGISTRATION FEES

Early Education (EE) classes: \$125.00 | Kindergarten-8th grade: \$200.00 Checks should be made payable to RRLS (Royal Redeemer Lutheran School). Registration fees are due at the time of registration and are *non-refundable*.

HOW TO REGISTER

Our fillable registration document is online at www.rrls.org. Hard copy registration forms are also available. Return completed forms to the school office along with registration fees. New this year, upon confirmation of your child's class and schedule, you will then set up an online portal to provide and/or update family information to complete the enrollment process.

Required documents due before August 1st

- Copy of the student's birth certificate or passport (if not already on file).
- Completed medical form (found on the "resources" page at www.rrls.org).
- Where applicable: custodial papers, IEP/504, health care plan and/or administration of medication forms.
