INSTRUCTIONAL RESOURCES

Student materials are funded by other sources, but staff materials are not. Reading, handwriting, and middle school social studies curriculum have all been updated for this school year.

K-8 PLAYGROUND

K-8 playground improvements are still being planned. We have reached a third of our fundraising goal to date. The current playground is nearing the end of its lifespan.
