Dear Royal Redeemer Family:

We've begun our 40-day Lenten journey so I thought I'd share some facts with you about...

using the color purple...

You may notice the use of the **color purple** in various ways, whether it be on the altar or the pastor's stole. But do you know why? In ancient times, the dye used to make purple was difficult to find. It was attributed to royalty, and adorned Christ only once - as He was mocked and ridiculed as the "King of the Jews" prior to His crucifixion. This deep hue has come to represent solemnity, penitence, and prayer as we reflect on the agony Jesus willingly endured for us.

giving something up...

From the perspective of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod, "giving something up for Lent" is entirely a matter of Christian freedom. Whether you do this or not, understand that the Bible never requires this. However, if you choose to give something up as a way of remembering the great sacrifice of Christ who gave up His life on the cross for your sin, then feel free to do so. Actually, I would suggest that, instead of giving something up, you commit a certain amount of time each day to connect with God in His Word.

During your Lenten journey, may God bless you as you experience the depth of Jesus' obedience and the wonder of His love to a world that so desperately needs to be saved!

CARE SPOTLIGHT Helping Hand Fund

Did you know ...

that we have been blessing others through our Helping Hand fund for 22 years? And what's even more awesome is your generosity. To date, RRLC has distributed \$251,955.45 – on average, that's \$11,400/year. This fund has provided us with avenues to interact with people within our congregation and in surrounding communities in ways we may not have been able to otherwise. When you give a monetary gift to this fund, we share the love of Jesus in tangible ways – from sending a Bible to a prisoner to providing lodging for someone escaping domestic violence.

We often partner with the City of North Royalton and other faith-based organizations and civic groups, like the Salvation Army and Love, Inc., which allows us to bless more individuals with financial assistance. When we assist those facing major life crises, we also offer ongoing spiritual support in the aftermath. We generally offer financial assistance one time to an individual.

Our donation boxes will be out soon to help replenish the fund. On the first Sunday of each month, the money collected in the boxes goes to a specific mission of the month project. The label on the front of the boxes will help you know where your dollars are going.
