STATE OF OHIO EDCHOICE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Scholarship amounts are prorated based on income. ALL families are eligible regardless of income level.

STEP ONE TO APPLY:

- Apply or re-enroll your student to attend RRLS at rrls.org/admissions/
- Complete the EdChoice Scholarship Program Request Form 2024-25 at rrls.org/financial-aid/
 - Complete one (separate) application for each eligible K-8 student
- · Return the completed, signed request form to our school office
- Include the following with your application:
 - Student's birth certificate
 - Proof of residence
 - e.g. utility bill (gas, water, electric)
 (Documentation must be in the primary parent/guardian's name. If you do not have a utility bill in your name, please contact the school office for appropriate documentation.)
 - Completed forms can be emailed to school@royred.org or dropped off at the school office

STEP TWO:

(Begin AFTER the school submits the above paperwork to the state of Ohio.)

- Create your OH ID Account at education.ohio.gov
- Set up your OH ID Profile by logging into your profile
- Complete your income verification through the ODE App
 - A copy of page one of Form 1040 from your 2023 tax return will be needed for this step
